Following up on last years well attended meeting, Provost Councillor Jimmy Gray has been invited to introduce this discussion which will include an update by a senior member of the Planning Department.

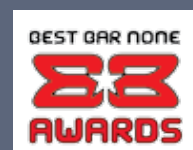
